## Nine employees are certified as specialists on Caterpillar 777D trucks.



The following three employees received a certification on Caterpillar 777D trucks from Relianz: Elkin Torres, the supervisor for the 777 Maintenance Area, Rodrigo Rodríguez, a technician from the same area, and supervisor Luis Rueda.

As part of the strategy aimed at improving the performance indicators for the fleet of coal and auxiliary trucks, three employees completed the evaluation that allowed them to become certified as specialists on Caterpillar 777D trucks. Technicians Alvaro Agudelo, Rodrigo Rodríguez, Onax Quiroga, Rolando Guerrero, Johan Guardela and Manuel Mallorquín Rocha; and supervisors Elkin Torres, Luis Horacio Rueda and Alvaro López completed the evaluation and fulfilled the Company goal of having at least three employees who are certified in each work group,

This evaluation and certification was conducted by instructors from the Training Department from Relianz Mining Solutions, and it lasted 80 hours over two weeks, including one theoretical and one practical evaluation.

Procedures like measuring the pressure of the trucks' hydraulic lift systems were studied during the course to receive this certification.

It gave us the tools we needed to improve our diagnostics, repairs and maintenance of this equipment, which undoubtedly motivates the staff and has an impact on the company's financial statements,"* noted Luis Rueda, maintenance supervisor for the fleet of 777 trucks.

## A new ambulance for the El Descanso medical unit.



One of the company's focuses in terms of healthcare is having increasingly modern equipment to provide medical care to its employees. For this reason, Drummond Ltd. purchased a new ambulance for the medical unit at the El Descanso mine.



The ambulance is equipped to transport up to 2 patients at a time and it has transfer equipment such as: oxygen, intubation equipment, electrocardiograph, a ventilator, infusion pump, suction, electronic vital sign monitors, and others, to provide high-quality medical care to the company's employees. With two vehicles at the El Descanso mine and two at the Pribbenow mine, for a total of four ambulances, the emergency response capacity at the mining operations is strengthened.
